

Response from Henry Timber on April 23, 2026

In response to EIA US's report, Henry Timber contacted EIA on April 23, 2026, and stated:

The establishment of a link between the entities cited in your study appears to result from a confusion that we wish to rectify. It is important to emphasize that the timber acquired and used for the "Plage des Sablettes" project was in no way sourced from the supplier Lumber Unipessoal. For your information, the timber used for this project is FSC-certified, thereby guaranteeing its responsible origin as well as full product traceability.

Furthermore, the analysis suggesting that the use of Cumaru wood necessarily implies sourcing from this specific supplier overlooks the complexity and diversity of the market structure. Henry Timber maintains a rigorous selection process for its partners and relies on a multiplicity of certified sources, ensuring total traceability throughout the supply chain.

Moreover, Henry Timber scrupulously complies with all applicable regulations. Our procedures and traceability audits are up to date and subject to regular verification by the relevant authorities, such as the FCBA.
